

COVID 19 MEASURES

- We continue to have measures in place to ensure your children and the staff are safe here at Lowbrook.

- Gives children the possibility of seeing that their ideas have value and that others have different ideas that have value too.
- Builds confidence, gives children a voice and can improve reading skills in terms of reading for understanding.

Please ensure your child is reading a variety of different texts and genres.

Reading Records are just for reading comments and other communication should now be through email to the school office.
