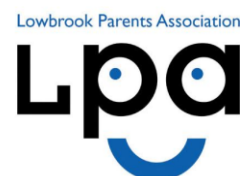

Dear Parents,

We have a number of events going on this term so I wanted to explain what we are doing and why. The Lowbrook Parents Association is responsible for raising money for your school which is spent on enhancing your children's experience at Lowbrook, our recent purchases include the projector and screen in the hall, the giant bean bags for reception classes and the outdoor speaker system which will be installed in the next couple of weeks onto the new building.
