Dear Cllr Bullock,


I am writing to express my disappointment in your lack of commitment to support Lowbrook Academy and the constituents of your local ward at the public RBWM Council Meeting last night whereby the additional capital for the Academy was debated and voted for.

Last night's vote was increasingly tight with 23 votes 'for' and 23 votes 'against', with the casting vote going to the Mayor. A vote of support by yourself would therefore have made all the difference in facilitating the school to move forward with the expansion that your constituents have been fighting for over many years and, as you are aware, in particular over the last eighteen months.

The decision reached by Council last night has left many Cox Green residents extremely disappointed and angry. It also called into question the hard work of the Academy's Governors and myself as Executive Principal who have worked tirelessly to fight for the expansion of this outstanding school. With your backing at the Council Meeting, this could have been avoided.

As a consequence of the support you failed to demonstrate towards your local constituents and towards your local school (the highest performing academy in England), I am publicly calling for you to consider your position as Ward Councillor of Cox Green.
