



Dear Parents/Caregivers,

Welcome to Term 4, below is an overview of what will be covered in Year 2 this term.

Language, Oracy and Literacy

As well as continuing the development of reading and writing skills, phonic and blends knowledge, spelling and grammar, the children will be spending part of this term exploring the novels of Roald Dahl. Also, they will be studying Information Texts where they will investigate non-fiction books/ICT texts on similar themes to show that they can give different information and present similar information in different ways.

Mathematics

Some of the many areas to be covered this term include:

- Measuring in centimetres using rulers, comparing and ordering lengths.
- Recognise and use symbols for pounds (£) and pence (p); combine amounts to make a particular value find different combinations of coins to equal the same amounts of money.
- Tell and write the time to five minutes, including quarter past/to the hour and draw the hands on a clock face to show these times.
- Identify and describe the properties of 2-D shapes, including the number of sides and symmetry in a vertical line.
- Identify and describe the properties of 3-D shapes, including the number of edges, vertices and faces
- Interpret and construct simple pictograms, tally charts, block diagrams and simple tables

Science and Technology

Our Science and Technology topic this term is Plants. Children will observe and describe how seeds and bulbs grow into mature plants. They will find out and describe how plants need water, light and a suitable temperature to grow and stay healthy.

Place and Time

Our Place and Time unit this term is focusing on famous people from the 20th Century. Children will be learning about Roald Dahl, The Beatles and Walt Disney. They will also have the opportunity to do some personal research on other famous people from the 20th Century. Research on countries studied during Arts and Culture week will also feature this term as well.

Physical and Emotional Health

In our dance unit this term the children will focus on creating and performing a theatrical dance to communicate how the habitats can inspire certain movements in dance. Outdoor games activities will consist of children improving and applying their basic skills in games in relation to netball and football. In all games activities, children will think about how to use skills, strategies and tactics to outwit the opposition.

Art & Creativity

The children will be exploring the Quentin Blake illustrations of the Roald Dahl books. Many drama activities will be carried out throughout the term in both literacy and Time & Place this, including hot seating of Roald Dahl characters. In music, they will be learning to create their own compositions, experimenting with a range of instruments, and notate them using graphics.

Faith and Belief

This term the children will be learning about Christianity focusing particularly on the Easter Story.

Citizenship and Ethics

This term the children will be learning about 'Sustainability'. They will learn about what we can do to help our environment. They will also be learning about what it means to purchase 'fair trade' goods. During Circle Time discussions, the children will discuss why it is 'Good to be Me'.

Homework

Spellings are given on a Monday and tested on Monday the following week, another piece of homework is given on Wednesday and Reading comprehension is given on Friday. Phonics homework may also be given during the week. The children will also be tested regularly on their times tables. Should you wish your child to be tested on a particular times table, please leave a note in their homework book.

We would ask you to read with your child daily, please make sure that you sign and date your child's reading log when you have heard them read. If there is anything that you would like to comment on, please feel free to do so in their diary.
