

Dear Parents and Carers,

Please find below a brief summary of the themes that Year 5 will be studying during Autumn Term 2.

English:

The children will look at Narrative Poetry (The Highwayman) in detail, looking at different characters from the poem and their motives for their actions. They will engage in drama and discussion and then plan and present an abridged version orally and visually. Children will discuss and reflect on their personal responses to the poem. They will also be involved in creating Observational poetry based on insect.

<u>Non Fiction</u> – Persuasive and Instructional text-Looking at features of persuasive writing and formulating persuasive arguments for and against a topic relevant to school life. They will be writing Christmas recipes using instructional text.

Mathematics:

Children will work on solving multi-step problems involving fractions, decimals and percentages. Calculating the perimeter and area of regular and irregular shapes. Ordering fractions, finding fractions and percentages of whole-number quantities. Reflections and translations and interpreting and reading timetables and other bars and charts.

Science and Technology:

The Earth and Space.

We will study the shapes and relative sizes of the Earth, Sun and Moon, how they move in relation to each other and how these movements relate to night and day.

The children will continue to study WW1 including Remembrance service on 9/11/18 and a life of individual heroes. In addition to our weekly Mandarin lessons, we will be studying architectural features of famous buildings and exploring landscape within China. We will be visiting the Ashmoleon museum at Oxford.
