- We are focusing on neat handwriting and presentation of work. All children should be writing in a cursive style (looped 'y', 'g', 'j').
- It would be greatly appreciated if you could support this at home by encouraging the correct pen grip and highlighting the importance of presentation for homework etc.

SATS

- Carried out any point in May.
- Children sit SPAG (2 spelling & punctuation/grammar), Reading (2 short & long) and Maths (2 Reasoning & Arithmetic) papers.
- Results will be given with end of year reports.
- Lastly... please do not panic!



Phonics



- Each morning, pupils receive a monster phonics lesson which will recap on all Year I sounds as well as teaching Year 2 sounds focussing on alternative spellings and pronunciations of sounds. For example the 'j' grapheme can be written as 'dge' as in 'bridge' or 'g' as in 'gem'.
- Pupils will continue to work with the monsters and each correspond to a colour which matches a sound.
- Pupils have been assessed and grouped accordingly to reflect their phonic knowledge for guided reading which happens 3 times a week. At the end of the week, pupils will take home the book they have been reading in school to independently read with you for the week. This develops reading fluency.









Reading

- An emphasis on mastery and fluency within reading and comprehension as per the National Curriculum.
- Exposure to a range of book genres.
- Please ask your child a range of questions before (from the cover), during and after reading. Using what, why, where, when, how.
- Children will be assessed every other term to determine their development in both fluency of reading and comprehension.
- Re-reading books is a necessary task, which we encourage.



Homework

Reading books will be changed on a

- Monday (sharing books)
- ► Wednesday (library books)
- Friday (Monster Phonics books).

It is expected that each child undertakes daily reading, and this is recorded in the reading record.

Monday: Reading comprehension (Google Classroom)

Tuesday: Handwriting/phonics sheet (in homework books)


Wednesday: Maths or Literacy - (Google Classroom/My Maths)
