## "Pheidippides" Times Tables Challenge

We are delighted to report that Lowbrook Academy pupils achieved first place in the "Pheidippidis" Times Tables Challenge run by the Spoore Merry Rixman Foundation. In this challenge 67% of pupils scored 100% and 25% scored between 95% and 99% meaning a total of 92% of pupils scored 95% or more.

The school has been awarded a prize of £1,500.00 by the Foundation which will be used to further develop financial literacy across the school and to further invest in IT programmes for times tables and arithmetic.

# **Prep and After School Club Procedures**

At the start of a new year we thought that it might be helpful to remind parents about some of the procedures for Prep and After School Club.

Prep Club runs daily from 3.15pm to 4.30pm. This is a quiet club which enables children to complete their homework under the supervision of a member of Lowbrook staff. To avoid disruption to this quiet space children may not be collected from this club before 4.15pm.

Children must be booked into Prep or After School Club by 2.30pm on the day of the booking. Ideally this should be done via the Scopay system, however, it is not possible to make same day bookings via Scopay so these bookings must be sent via email to the school office.

Any child not booked into a club by 2.30pm will be sent to After School Club and if they are not collected from After School Club by 3.30pm parents will be charged for the full session.

The Prep and After School Club phone will be switched on from 3.30pm so please remain patient if trying to collect your child at this time.
