Lowbrook Academy is taking part in Waste Week this March, along with more than 1,600 schools from across the UK and overseas. Waste Week is run by EDF Energy's schools programme The Pod. This year's campaign focuses on plastic waste.

Lowbrook Academy prides itself on keeping well informed with current affairs and using these topics to enrich our curriculum and broaden the children's outlook. It is with this in mind that we are participating in The Pod's Waste Week 2019 and its focus on plastic waste. The disposal of single-use plastic and the environmental issues surrounding it are dominating the headlines; so our theme for Waste Week this year will be to reduce and reuse plastic.

Waste Week 2019 will be taking place at Lowbrook Academy from Monday 25th March to Friday 29th March. The whole school will be taking part in a variety of activities, such as a special collection of plastic bottle tops and classroom lessons based on pollution. This is to inform them about the consequences of not only the disposal of plastic, but of what impact pollution has on the world.
