##### Kindness Cup

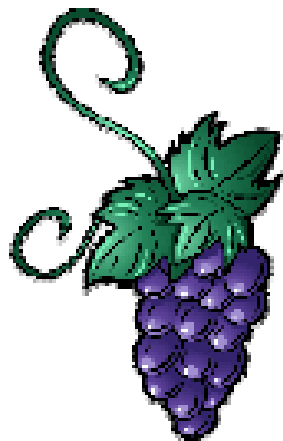
