Health and Safety on the School Site

The health and safety of pupils at Lowbrook is the number one priority for us all. We therefore wanted to remind Parents and Caregivers of some of the Lowbrook site procedures based on the observations of staff over the past few weeks.

Kiss and Drop Facility

This is only to be used between 8.00am and 8.55am when a member of Lowbrook staff is present.

It is also only to be used by KS2 children, or KS1 children when accompanied by a KS2 sibling.

It must not be used by unaccompanied EYFS and KS1 children.

Morning Drop Off

Staff have noticed an increasing number of unaccompanied children waiting outside the school from 7.45am. Children must not arrive at Lowbrook before the start of Breakfast Club at 8.00am as there are no staff present to supervise them.

Staff have also noticed an increasing number of unaccompanied children arriving at school from 8.30am and waiting outside for the playground gates to open at 8.45am. In future, these children will be sent into Breakfast Club where they can be supervised by staff, and parents will be charged Breakfast Club rates.

Scouting and Cycling on the School Site

We encourage all children to walk, scoot or cycle to school wherever possible, however, all scooters and bicycles must be dismounted at the blue pedestrian gates and taken to the bike/scooter shelter. They must not be ridden on the school site or in the playground.

If a staff member asks your child to dismount their scooter or bicycle please can you follow their instructions.

Parking

Staff have noticed cars parking daily along the playground fence at pick up time. These cars block the entrance to the school and cause congestion. To avoid this, please ensure that parking is restricted to the marked bays only.




